D-Lite™ v1.8

D-Lite™ is a software program that allows you to easily manage an *IntelliProx* cardholder database. The program provides you with a user-friendly interface for card management, using a spreadsheet format (such as Microsoft Excel™). An extensive online help file places assistance at your fingertips. Communication between the *D-Lite* program and the *IntelliProx* unit is done through a serial connection made directly between the *IntelliProx* and an open serial port on the host computer. The *D-Lite* program can handle up to 500 cards per *IntelliProx* unit, and can handle a virtually unlimited number of *IntelliProx* units.

D-Lite makes it easy to create a cardholder database, upload that database to an *IntelliProx* unit, download a cardholder database from an *IntelliProx* unit into the *D-Lite* program, and merge two cardholder databases into one combined database. It also allows you to immediately lock or unlock the door attached to the *IntelliProx* unit.

D-Lite is a fully functional Windows™ program, making full use of all popular Windows features such as resizing and relocating windows, drag-and-drop functions, multiple windows open simultaneously, background operation, and "real-time" operation.

Compatibility

- *D-Lite* operates under Windows 95™, Windows 98™, and Windows NT™.
- *D-Lite* is not compatible with Windows 3.1™ or MS-DOS™.

Product Documentation

The CD-ROM release of *D-Lite* software includes copies of technical documentation in Adobe Acrobat® PDF format. It also includes the Adobe Acrobat installation program (version 4 of the free PDF reader program). The Adobe Acrobat PDF format is a universal document display format that allows an end user to view and print copies of documents.

NOTE: The documents on the CD-ROM are the current revisions at the time of CD-ROM release. However, these documents are subject to change at any time. If necessary, please contact Tech Support at Keri Systems to verify the current revision of any document.



If the Acrobat Reader is not already installed on the host computer, follow these instructions to run the Acrobat Reader installation program.

1. Insert the *D-Lite* installation CD-ROM into the host computer's CD-ROM drive.
2. Use the Windows Explorer program to locate the Acrobat Reader "Acrd4enu.exe" program on the CD-ROM. This program is found in the \Acroread\Installers\ folder.
3. Double-click on the "Acrd4enu.exe" program icon and the installation program begins. Follow the instructions displayed on screen.
4. When the installation process is complete close the Windows Explorer program and locate the Acrobat Reader shortcut that has been displayed on the host computer's desktop.

Once the Acrobat Reader program has been installed on the host computer there are two ways to access documentation on the *D-Lite* CD-ROM.

1. Double-click on the Acrobat Reader shortcut icon. The Reader program opens. Click on the File > Open pull-down menu option. A standard Windows open file window appears. Use the navigation tools to locate the *D-Lite* CD-ROM. Click on the \Docs folder for technical documentation. A list of the folder's PDF documents appears. Either double-click on the desired file or click on the file and then click on the OPEN button.
2. Open the Windows Explorer program. On the *D-Lite* CD-ROM, navigate to the \Docs folder for technical documentation. A list of PDF documents appears. Double-click on the desired file and the Reader program opens with that file as its contents.

The List.txt file in the \Docs folder provides a list of the PDF files found in the folder.
